Amend the Major Street Plan for proposed road at 5700 W. between California Ave. & 2100 S. - A proposed ordinance is before the Council that would amend the Major Street Plan of the Salt Lake City Transportation Master to remove a proposed collector street located at 5700 West between California Avenue (1300 South) and 2100 South Street Frontage road (State Road – SR-201). A collector street moves traffic from local streets to arterial roads. The proposal would change the Master Plan for a proposed street located at 5700 West between California Avenue (1300 South) and 2100 South Street Frontage Road to specify that should a street be necessary in the future, a local street – rather than a collector street – would be installed. This change is related to UDOT’s decision to locate the Mountain View Corridor in the area. Petitioner – Former Mayor Becker, Petition No. PLNPCM2014-00586.
