

**TAYLORSVILLE CITY COUNCIL

MEETING DATE: March 2, 2016

AGENDA ITEM: Appointment of Don Quigley [District 1]; Herman (John) Warnas [District 5]; Noah Bater [At-Large]; and Richard Morley [Alternate At-Large] to the Taylorsville Planning Commission.

SUMMARY: On February 11, 2016 a committee made up of Mayor Larry Johnson, Council Chair Ernest Burgess, and Council Vice-Chair Brad Christopherson made the following recommendation to the City Council to fill the current vacancies on the Taylorsville Planning Commission:

1. Move Don Quigley from a fulltime at-large position to the vacant District 1 position (term expires June 30, 2018). This appointment fills the position recently vacated by Israel Grossman who resigned January 21, 2016.
2. Appoint Herman (John) Warnas to the District 5 position (term expires June 30, 2019). This appointment fills the position currently held by Dale Kehl who has indicated his intention to resign from the Planning Commission once a replacement has been appointed.
3. Appoint Noah Bater to the fulltime at-large position currently held by Don Quigley (term expires June 30, 2018).
4. Appoint Richard Morley to the vacant alternate at-large position (term expires June 30, 2016). This position was last held by Don Quigley who was appointed to a fulltime position on November 4, 2015.

Please note that Planning Commission terms are staggered by ordinance so that two positions expire each year. As a result, each of these appointments will fulfill the remainder of the applicable terms rather than being full four year appointments. In the case of Mr. Morley, the alternate position expires on June 30th of this year. At that point Mr. Morley will be eligible to be reappointed to a full four year term.

A breakdown of the current Planning Commission (contingent on these appointments being approved by the Council) is illustrated on the attached *Planning Commission History – July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2016* table.
