**Sanitary Sewer Management Program**

Jamie Grandpre, Senior Wastewater Operator reviewed this plan with the members during the  
work session. The State is requiring a permit for the sewer collection system. Jamie has written  
a plan detailing the City's sewer collection system that he would like to submit to the State. It is  
basically everything the City has already been doing, just in written form. This written plan  
needs to be submitted to the State by the end of March. Jamie and Council had some discussion  
on what is contained in this written plan.

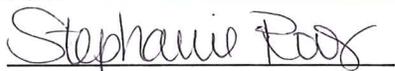
Fran presented Jamie with a gift from the City in recognition of this award.
