




Delinquency Scores and Delinquency History by PSRA Risk Level

PSRA Risk Level Breakdown



This shows the breakdown of all PSRAs from CY 2015. There were a total of 6,703 PSRAs administered in CY 2015. Of those, 53.7% were classified as low risk.






PSRA DELINQUENCY HISTORY SCORE BY RISK LEVEL

This section analyzes the delinquency history score for each risk level. Because this is done at the assessment level, one individual could have had 2 or more assessments done in a single year. There were a total of 6,703 PSRAs completed in CY 2015, and a total of 5,493 youth.

Delinquency History Scores for Youth Identified as Low Risk on PSRA




Of the 3,597 assessments in this category, none received a delinquency history score higher than seven. Sixty percent of the PSRAs given to these youth scored from 0 to 3 with a steady decline from 2 to 7.


Delinquency History Scores for Youth Identified as Moderate Risk on PSRA



There were a total of 2,009 PSRAs which classified youth as being moderate risk to reoffend. Of these assessments, eighty-one percent received a score between 3 and 8.



Delinquency History Scores for Youth Identified as High Risk on PSRA




Of the 1,097 PSRAs classifying youth as high risk, none received a delinquency history score of a 0, 1 or 2. Forty-three percent of these youth scored between 8 and 10 in their delinquency history.




DELINQUENCY HISTORY BY PSRA RISK LEVEL

This section analyzes the average delinquency history of all youth who were given an assessment in CY 2015. This is done at the individual-risk level. This means that a youth could be counted more than once if they had multiple assessments with different risk levels. In most cases where a youth had more than one assessment, they received the same risk level. There were a total of 5,463 individual youth who received a PSRA, and there were 5,967 unique case-risk levels. This was done to obtain the average number of offenses for each risk level.
