

Changes to the March 23 version landscaping code, the revised file now known as the April landscaping code.

1. Subparagraphs were added to almost all paragraphs for ease of reference and locating parts of the code.
2. Paragraph A-1 added defining to who and when the code applies. Paragraph A reformatted for added clarity.
3. Paragraph B the word "structure" replaced with the word "main building" for clarity. Side yards and rear yard further defined.
4. The statement, "The decision of the council is final" in C-1, last line, was removed.
5. Paragraphs C-2 and C-3 were reworded requiring the building inspector verify landscape work is completed prior to bond release.
6. Paragraph D-4 added, sheds and accessory buildings are not part of landscaping.
7. Paragraph E rewritten to define the front yard and to clarify what is allowed in the front yard and what is not. Added a grandfather clause for existing front yards with pasture, corrals, barns, coops, and so forth.
8. Paragraph G-2 and G-3 has text added so that street trees apply only to new permits.
9. Paragraph J-1 yards requiring landscape and watering system maintenance further defined.
10. Paragraph J-2 non-landscaped rear yards added to those areas requiring weed control.
