

**RICH COUNTY COMMISSION
MINUTES
MARCH 2, 2016**

The Rich County Commission Meeting was held on March 2, 2016 at the County Courthouse in Randolph, Utah beginning at 10:00 a.m. Those present were Chairman William E. Cox, Commissioner Norman A. Weston, Commissioner Thomas J. Weston and Clerk Rebecca Peart.

A motion was made by Tom Weston and seconded by Norm Weston and unanimously passed to approve the March 2, 2016 agenda as presented.

Kent Whatcott and Gary Ketsdever with the Sons of the American Legion met with the Commission to request a used **flag receptacle** be placed in the Courthouse. They would like the public to have a place to bring old flags and then they would be disposed of properly. Norm Weston made a motion to allow them to place a receptacle in the Courthouse as long as it matches the existing furniture. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed. They also made a request to have two **plaques they had received placed in the Courthouse**. Tom Weston made a motion to allow the Sons of the American Legion to place the plaques in the Courthouse. Norm Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed. Gary stated they will soon be placing the **new flag poles** on the Courthouse grounds. He would like the Commission help pay for the cement. The Commission would like them to see if they could get the cement donated or at a lower rate.

Mitch Poulsen Director of Bear Lake Regional Commission and Gary Mckee representing Cisco Road Partners met with the Commission to **request a re-zone** from Agricultural to Residential. This matter was on the February Planning and Zoning agenda for a Public Hearing and was passed on to the County Commission. A map was given to the Commission of the location. Norm Weston made a motion to grant the re-zone from Agricultural to Residential. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed. Mitch presented the **Utah Waypoint Grant** to the Commission. He had applied and received \$25,000. The money will be used for helping to add to the bike path. Tom Weston made a motion to allow the Chairman's signature on the grant for bike path expansion from Vista Grande to First Point which is approximately a quarter mile. Norm Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed. Mitch gave an update on the **County Resource Management Plan**. He stated he has been working on it and presented a handout of items that need to be covered on the plan. Mitch ask the Commission to help prioritize the list. Which they did at that time.

Jill Parker Public Relations Director with Bear River Health Department met with the Commission to present the 2015 Annual Report. The report was reviewed and also many of their Services. Different programs they offer were discussed. Randolph and Garden City have buildings that house the Health Department.

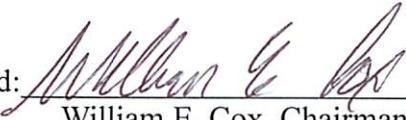
Kim Wilson Rich County Assessor met with the Commission to discuss personal property exemptions. Assessor Wilson presented **personal property** exemptions that she had received. The Commissioners reviewed each application. Norm Weston made a motion to approve the personal property exemptions as presented. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously approved. Kim had received a new application for exemption. The exemption request is for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latterday Saints. It is for the building that is used exclusively for the Handcart Trek site. Tom Weston made a motion to approve the **real property exemptions** of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints for the year 2016 and the Bear Lake Community Health Center exemption. Norm Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed.

Scott Jacobson Rich County Sanitation Supervisor met with the Commission to discuss Sanitation business. Part time help was discussed. The Annual report to the State was reviewed. Tom Weston made a motion to accept the Annual Sanitation report. Norm Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed.

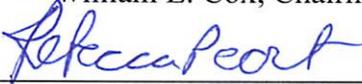
