1. **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL** – Chair Bob Ford called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The following members of the Rockville Planning Commission were present: Karen Lodinger (via telephone), Jane Brennan, and Linda Brinkley. Cheryl McGovern was excused. Deputy Town Clerk Vicki S. Bell recorded the meeting.
2. **DECLARATION OF CONFLICTS OF INTEREST WITH AN AGENDA ITEM** – There were no conflicts of interest declared.
3. **TABLED FROM THE FEBRUARY 09, 2016, MEETING – ACTION ON A REQUEST FOR A TEMPORARY USE/SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT FOR THE ZION 100 TRAIL RUN IN ROCKVILLE FOR APRIL 8-9, 2016** – It was reported that this is the fifth year the race has been run. Event representative, Salem Stanley, was present and reported that the setup is the same as in years past. The only areas that concern the Town of Rockville are where runners come off the mesa and a small aid station near the cemetery. There will be another aid station on Grafton Mesa on BLM land. Mr. Stanley indicated that this is the third year the race has used this configuration. The race will not take place on main roads and runners will remain on trails. Mr. Stanley verified that all necessary insurance coverages are in place as well as fire and emergency policies and a trash removal plan. Chair Ford reported that the portion of the race that comes through Rockville will take place later in the afternoon and into the evening. Mr. Stanley stated that the Rockville portion is Mile 57 of the 100-mile race. Currently, there are 100 runners registered for the 100-mile run and 700 for the entire event. Only the 100-mile runners will run through Rockville.

Jane Brennan's understanding was that this is a zero trash race. Mr. Stanley confirmed that that is the case and stated that even toilet waste is composted. At aid stations, plastic cups will not be used. Ceramic dishware will be used instead that will be washed and reused. He made the Planning Commissioners aware that the event was ultra-adventurous until the organizers included the Half Marathon the two merged. The same people are putting on the Zion Half Marathon this weekend.

Linda Brinkley **MOVED** to accept the application for a Temporary Use/Special Event Permit for the Zion 100 Trail Run that will occur on April 8-9, 2016 in Rockville. The application was determined to be complete and insurances and all details have been taken care of and are in order. Jane Brennan **SECONDED** the motion.

Hatfield, Megan Honer-Orton, and Pam Leach. The desire was to have the matter on the April agenda and conduct the public hearing in May.

6. **ADJOURN** – Jane Brennan **MOVED** to adjourn. Linda Brinkley **SECONDED** the motion.


