# Preschool through Post High

- Preschool and fully accredited K-12 program
- Highly structured learning environment adapted to blind/visually impaired students
- Achieve Individualized Education Program goals
- Receive adaptive physical education, art, music, orientation and mobility, and related services as needed
- Technology & adaptive technology
- Student's appropriate media identified through learning media assessment (determines braille, large print, speech output)



# Specialized Services

- Emphasis on the ECC (Expanded Core Curriculum) in areas that need explicit and systematic instruction:
- Braille, technology, O&M, independent living skills, social skills, career education, self-advocacy, sensory efficiency, recreation/leisure
- Supported Transition Extension Program (STEP)-- 16 years and older; target transition and career readiness skills needed to reach individual potential, independent living, support employment, trade school and/or technical college; student-centered, outcome-based, and inclusive.
