A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF TAYLORSVILLE CITY BOARD PROVIDING FOR YEAR-END FINAL AMENDMENTS TO THE BALANCED BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2015 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2016
