

**RICH COUNTY COMMISSION
MINUTES
APRIL 6, 2016**

The Rich County Commission Meeting was held on April 6, 2016 at the County Courthouse in Randolph, Utah beginning at 10:00 a.m. Those present were Chairman William E. Cox, Commissioner Norman A. Weston, Commissioner Thomas J. Weston and Clerk Rebecca Peart.

A motion was made by Tom Weston and seconded by Norm Weston and unanimously passed to approve the April 6, 2016 agenda as presented with the removal of the Barrel Club and the addition of Dale Wilson Rich County Road Supervisor.

Dale Wilson Rich County Road Supervisor met with the Commission and stated he had received 3 bids on a 9500 Gallon Vertical Plastic Storage Tank. Low Bid was from Dustbusters in the amount of \$7100.00. Norm Weston made a motion to allow the Road Supervisor to purchase the Poly Tank from Dustbusters in the amount of \$7100.00. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed. Dale also had bids on cattleguards. Tom Weston made a motion to allow the Road Department to purchase from Bear Bottom Rentals 2 cattleguards in the amount of \$3,900.00 . Norm Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed. Dale submitted bids for striping county roads. Low bid was from All Star Striping. Norm Weston made a motion to allow the Road Supervisor to contract with All Star Striping in the amount of \$23,473.00 for striping of 33 miles of County Road. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed.

Gary Heward Rich County Attorney, Dale Stacey and Kim Wilson with Rich County Ambulance met with the Commission on an Ambulance Bill that had gone to Small Claims. A boy at the Scout Camp had an allergic reaction. The Scout Camp had called the ambulance. The parents had talked to the above individuals and the individuals said they would bring it to the Commission. The Commission was not willing to forgive the debt and would like them to look into the matter further.

Kim Wilson Rich County Assessor met with the Commission to discuss personal property exemptions. Assessor Wilson presented **personal property** exemptions that she had received. The Commissioners reviewed each application. Norm Weston made a motion to approve the personal property exemptions as presented. Tom Weston seconded the motion and unanimously approved.

Lou Jean Argyle Rich County Treasurer and Debra Ames Rich County Recorder met with the Commission and gave them an updated list of the 2016 May Tax Sale. The properties were discussed. **County Logos were discussed.** Lou Jean stated 5 logos had been submitted from the contest. The Commission would like her to have all the elected officials review and rate the submitted logos.

The **Bear Lake Special Service District** submitted for approval a list of their members. The Commission had concerns and questions. A member of the Commission will talk to the Special Service District.

Tom Weston made a motion to allow the **Rich County Council of the Aging to purchase 2, 2016 Chevrolet Exuinox** for the meals on wheels program. The cost is 23,883.00 each. Norm Weston seconded the motion and unanimously passed.

A motion was made by Norm Weston seconded by Tom Weston and unanimously passed to allow the Sanitation Supervisor to hire Vaughn Murphy as **full time-part time for the landfill.** Beginning salary of \$10.00 an hour.


