



Pooled Services - Violent Crimes Unit

The Violent Crimes Unit investigated the following in Taylorsville:

- **2/29/16** Stabbing: 2 suspects were arrested.
- **3/15/16** Deseret First C.U. Robbery: Currently waiting for DNA analysis. No suspect leads at this time.
- **3/17/16** Mountain America C.U. Robbery: No suspect leads at this time. The money was recovered.

Taylorsville - Investigations Unit

- On 1/7/2016, Detective Fowler assisted MGU and Millcreek patrol units tracking a stolen vehicle and assisting in the apprehension of the suspects. During the incident, the driver intentionally rammed Detective Fowler's vehicle. One of the suspects fled from the vehicle but was apprehended by Detective Fowler after a foot pursuit.
- On 1/13/16, Detective Neal received information that a wanted fugitive was at an address in Midvale. The fugitive was located inside of the residence and was booked into jail.
- On 1/14/16, Detective Bennett developed information regarding the possible location of a wanted fugitive who had fled from officers the previous week. He was located and arrested. Detectives located and seized over an ounce of heroin, methamphetamine, and stolen property. A female associate was also arrested. Both were booked into jail.
- On 1/15/16, Detective Lovendahl located an occupied stolen vehicle in WVC. She blocked the vehicle and the driver was arrested. He was a parole fugitive listed as armed and dangerous.
- On 1/20/15, Detective Miller and MGU executed a search warrant at a storage unit in West Jordan as part of an ongoing drug investigation. Detectives located and seized 14 ounces of marijuana, 25 grams of psilocybin mushrooms and drug paraphernalia.
- On 1/21/15, Detective Lovendahl received information that a wanted fugitive was at an address in Murray. She and Detective Lloyd went to the residence and apprehended the individual without incident.
- On 1/22/15, Detective Miller and MGU served a drug search warrant at an address in Murray. Detectives located and seized 1,061 grams of methamphetamine, one pound of heroin, cocaine, marijuana, and \$830 in cash. One adult male was booked into jail.

- During the previous week, on 1/21/16, Detective Lovendahl developed intelligence information regarding a possible load car coming to SLC from California. She provided Nevada Highway Patrol with the vehicle information and it was located near Ely, NV. A drug dog alerted to the presence of drugs and the truck was searched. 9.5 pounds of cocaine was located inside of a modified air compressor. The driver was identified by his fingerprints. He had been deported from the US 9 times.
- On 2/2/16, Detective Bennett conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle leaving a suspected drug location in Taylorsville. The suspect provided a false name and personal information. A search warrant was obtained for his apartment. Detectives served the warrant and located over 1 gram of heroin, packaging material, and \$7337 in cash. One adult was booked into jail.
- On 2/2/16, Detective Neal located a recently stolen vehicle at a location in Taylorsville. He held surveillance and subsequently observed an individual enter the car and begin to drive off. A traffic stop was conducted and the driver, a known VLT gang member, was taken into custody. In addition to the auto theft, he also had multiple outstanding warrants for his arrest. One male was booked into jail.
- On 2/5/16, Detective Neal stopped a suspicious vehicle in Taylorsville. The driver was a wanted felon and was arrested. He admitted to being in the area to purchase methamphetamine. He was booked into jail.
- On 2/10/16, NSC and Investigations detectives executed three search warrants throughout the valley as part of a joint investigation with Utah MC Task Force. Detectives located and seized 2 pounds of heroin, 3 ounces of cocaine, and \$10,000 cash. Case agent: Lovendahl.

- On 2/11/16, Detective Lovendahl obtained information regarding a pending drug deal. NSC detectives observed the transaction occur and conducted a traffic stop. UPD K9 responded and gave a positive indication on the vehicle. Detectives located and seized nearly 10 ounces of methamphetamine.
- On 2/12/16, Sgt. Miller observed a vehicle that had fled from WJPD abandoned near the Walmart. A containment perimeter was established and two occupants were located. Both had outstanding warrants.
- On 2/12/16, NSC detectives received intelligence that two wanted fugitives were at a room at Crossland Suites. Detectives made contact with one of the occupants and located the two fugitives hiding in the bathroom. Both were booked into jail. Case agent: Sgt. Miller.
- On 2/18/16, Detective Bennett received information that a drug deal was going to occur at a parking lot along Redwood Road. Detectives established surveillance and observed the suspect vehicle. A traffic stop was conducted and a hidden compartment was found. Detectives located and seized 5 ounces of heroin, ¼ ounce of cocaine, and \$4793 cash.
- On 2/19/16, NSC detectives assisted Officer Pender on an occupied stolen vehicle. Detectives located the vehicle and deployed tire deflation spikes. The driver, Brian Winters, abandoned the vehicle and fled on foot. Officer Pender located the suspect hiding nearby.
- On 2/22/16, NSC and Investigations detectives assisted patrol officers in serving a search warrant at a Taylorsville residence. Detectives located and seized methamphetamine, marijuana, and drug paraphernalia. The SLCO Health Department was contacted and closed the residence to occupancy. A female adult was arrested.

- On 2/28/16, NSC assisted by Utah County Major Crimes Unit served search warrants at two locations. UPD SWAT served one of the search warrants because the suspect was believed to be armed and dangerous. Detectives located and seized 1 pound of methamphetamine, several pounds of marijuana, several ounces of cocaine, over \$11,000 in cash, and 5 handguns. Case agent: Sgt. Miller.
- On 3/2/16, Detective Neal conducted a traffic stop on a suspicious vehicle. He located steroids and syringes in the car.
- On 3/4/16, Detective Lovendahl received information that a male was selling methamphetamine at a street corner in Taylorsville. Detective Neal approached the male and purchased methamphetamine from him. The suspect was immediately arrested and found to be in possession of several bags of methamphetamine and booked into jail.

He was able to stop the suspect leaving the residence and located small amounts of heroin and methamphetamine in the vehicle. Detective Bennett obtained a search warrant for the suspect's apartment and served it. Detectives located drug paraphernalia inside.
- On 3/7/16, NSC detectives assisted on a man with a gun call. AP&P recognized the address as belonging to a parole fugitive. AP&P agents and NSC detectives held surveillance and stopped a car leaving there. The fugitive was inside of the vehicle and was apprehended.
- On 3/10/16, Detective Lovendahl and Officer Van Leeuwen were investigating a drug case at Walmart. They encountered the male suspect as he fled from them on foot. He was apprehended and booked into jail on an outstanding felony warrant.

- On 3/11/16, WVC PD was in pursuit of an armed robbery suspect. Sergeant Miller was able to successfully deploy spikes. The occupants abandoned the vehicle and fled on foot. They were apprehended and four firearms were recovered.

- On 3/17/16, Detectives Lovendahl and Lloyd observed a drug deal in the Walmart parking lot. The exchange was interrupted by the detectives. Detectives located and seized 29 grams of heroin and 1.3 grams of cocaine.
- On 3/18/16, Detective Lovendahl located an occupied stolen car in the Fresh Market parking lot. The occupants were detained. One of the occupants confessed to a burglary where a vehicle had been stolen. Detective Clark located that vehicle and recovered it. Two of the occupants were booked into jail.
