WHEREAS, Huntington City has a need to open the General Fund for adjustments in revenues and expenditures;
and

WHEREAS, the public interest will be best served by adjusting the budget for the fiscal year 2016,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Huntington City Council that; on the recommendation of the budget officer make the following budget adjustments:

General Fund: Changes made in the following departments:

General Government - increase budget from \$245,700.00 to \$247,200.00

Public Safety - increase budget from \$96,013.00 to \$96,413.00

Highways and Public Improvements - increase budget from \$214,000.00 to \$215,000.00

Parks, Recreation and Public Property – increase budget from \$211,364.00 to \$212,289.00

Total increase in expenditures \$3,825.00

Capital Projects Fund: increase revenue and expenses from \$44,287.00 to \$46,900.00

Utility Fund: decrease revenue from \$394,000.00 to \$372,500.00 - decrease expenses from \$370,857.00 to \$361,932.00

Secondary Fund: decrease expenses from \$43,615.00 to \$33,615.00

Perpetual Care Fund: increase revenue and expenses from \$4,700.00 to \$5,070.00

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that other adjustments will be made as needed and recommended by the budget officer to all of the funds which may or may not affect the total budgeted amounts for those funds to be in compliance with state codes and that will balance the budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption and replaces any resolution in conflict therewith.
