



SPRINGVILLE CITY PARKS & RECREATION BOARD

Minutes of the meeting held on April 28, 2016

Community Services Building – 443 S 200 E– 6:30 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER: Meeting called to order by Marc Penrod at 6:43 p.m.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: Julie Kappas made a motion to approve amended minutes of the meeting held on March 23, 2016. Lynn Bartholomew seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Lynn drove by the community park and there was hardly room to drive because people were parked on both sides of the road. He suggested putting up a sign directing people to the north parking lot.

RECREATION UPDATE: Spring soccer is two weeks from being over. Corey Merideth thinks that in the next couple of years spring soccer will be bigger than fall soccer. Started urban fishing program (age 6-10) at Bartholomew Park. A track & field club will also be started. Over 100 kids are signed up (age 8-15).

ART CITY DAYS: Corey held a meeting last Monday. Everything is nailed down. Good Dinosaur will play at the Arts Park and Captain Phillips will play at Bartholomew Park. Corey passed out schedule of events. Volleyball tournament is at Bartholomew Park. Fox 13 and Big Buddha are coming for the balloon fest. Parade float is in process at Creative Designs.

COUNTY RECREATION GRANT: Corey said the golf course needs help with a food and beverage cart more than a simulator. Food cart will bring in more revenue than a simulator. Corey went over new proposals. Katie Sosa wanted to know what kind of revenue from food/beverage cart. Other courses make good money.

AQUATICS CENTER: We are set with the program for the building. Put the hot tub back in the leisure side. Architects are working on designs and drawings. Alex Roylance explained liquefaction issue with the site. Solution from contractor is to use a machine that will drill 30 foot hole under the pool, then fill it with clay and aggregates. Plans will bring building five feet up out of the ground. This will cost about \$600,000. Hopefully, we will be moving ground in July and building construction begins in October.

ARBOR DAY: Program is tomorrow at Reagan Academy at 9:00 a.m. Next year is at Sage Creek Elementary.

PARKS UPDATE: Budget will have \$475,000 for park development next year. Proposals are A-finish west side of Bartholomew Park including landscaping, lights in parking lots, playgrounds, tables and benches; B-just landscaping at Bartholomew Park and more play fields in the community park. The Utah County grant is still a possibility. GSBS is working with our plan of the community park. Plan is split up in half million dollar phases. Board recommends spending all the \$475,000 to finish Wayne Bartholomew Family Park. Putting trail behind houses where it was originally supposed to be.

ACTION ITEMS:

- Julie Kappas made a motion to recommend distribution of County Recreation grant as follows.
 1. \$7,500- Food/beverage cart for Hobble Creek Golf Course.
 2. \$4,500- Homerun fencing for Pony field at Bird Park and softball field at Kolob Park.
 3. \$2,500- Portable football field goal posts at the community park.
 4. \$1,000- Drain grating at the splash pad.
 5. \$ 500- Soft toss nets at Bird Park.
 6. \$ 994- Dirt for improvements at Rodeo Arena.
- Katie Sosa seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 8:11p.m.
