



SPRINGVILLE CITY PARKS & RECREATION BOARD
Minutes of the meeting held on May 26, 2016
Wayne Bartholomew Family Park – 1090 South 2900 East– 6:30 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER: Meeting called to order by Gary Hooper at 6:30 p.m.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: Katie Sosa made a motion to approve minutes of the meeting held on April 28, 2016. Marc Penrod seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Katie's neighbors are upset about the Bird Park playground being taken out. Alex Roylance explained that the playground was old and it would be very, very expensive to get parts to repair it. Playgrounds must pass an inspection for safety and this playground was unsafe. Hopefully a new playground can be installed in the future. Tennis Courts at Memorial Park are falling apart. We have tennis courts at Springville High School, the new Springville Jr High, and the Arts Park. Staff will be taking care of weeds there. It would cost tens of thousands of dollars to re-surface the court at Memorial Park.

RECREATION UPDATE: Corey Merideth reported that we just finished first season of spring soccer and over 500 kids participated. Baseball and softball are in full swing. Springville is hosting the Rocky Mountain Baseball tournament. Marc has heard lots of good comments about the new track program. There are 114 kids in the program. Art city Classic was last week.

ART CITY DAYS: The celebration starts Saturday, June 4th. Lisa Willey is the parade chairman. There will be activities every day through June 11th.

AQUATICS CENTER: There's not much to report this month. We are still trying to get the budget figured out. Hopefully we will be moving dirt in July.

ARBOR DAY REPORT: Reagan Academy had a great program and the sixth grade students planted 10 trees.

PARKS UPDATE: Tomorrow at 3:00 p.m. at Clyde Park, a tree will be planted to honor Bob Frazier, former long-time Parks and Recreation Board member. Weather makes it interesting to keep the parks sprayed and mowed. Budget still has \$450,000 for Bartholomew Park. No more parking will be added at this time. Park should be under construction by August and completed before winter. Lights are installed in parking lot at this park.

Alex is retiring from Springville City on August 15th. He will be greatly missed!
