RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council awards the Pony Express Memorial Cemetery Monument Extension and Fence bid to Utah Correctional Industries (UCI) in the amount of \$77,500.00 as a “not to exceed” price and authorizes the Mayor to sign the contract.

BACKGROUND:

In early 2016, Eagle Mountain City awarded a contract to Utah Correctional Industries (UCI) in the amount of \$40,000.00 to complete an entry monument for the Pony Express Memorial Cemetery. In conjunction with this project there was an Eagle Scout tree planting project. Additional trees were planted on April 29, 2016 (Arbor Day).

The cemetery is the final resting place for 13 persons. An additional 40 plots have been purchased. The cemetery wall will divide the front phase of the cemetery from Eagle Mountain Boulevard. The extension of the monument and fencing will further define the cemetery’s location.

The project would consist of the contractor (UCI) purchasing and installing all materials applicable to the Pony Express Memorial Cemetery monument extension and fence. The monument wall will need step-downs added as the extension portions of the entry. The fencing will be commercial grade rod iron fencing in 20’ sections with a 6” x 6” mow strip. The dimensions of the pillars will be 27” x 27” x 4’ tall, matching the existing monument entry.
