**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM
THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE'S JUSTICE ASSISTANCE
GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$31,334 FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT
EQUIPMENT UPDATES AND PROGRAM OVERTIME**

WHEREAS, the Taylorsville City Council (the "Council") met in regular session on July 6, 2016, to consider, among other things, accepting a grant from the United States Department of Justice's Justice Assistance Grant program ("JAG") in the amount of \$31, 334 for law enforcement equipment updates and program overtime (the "Grant"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville (the "City") has received notice from the United States Department of Justice that the above-referenced Grant has been awarded to the City; and

WHEREAS, TAYLORSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE § 2.32.180 provides, among other things, that any grant that anticipates or proposes to bind the City to a particular project or contract shall be submitted to the Council for approval prior to accepting the grant; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to provide law enforcement services, make applications for grants, and administer such grants; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City to accept this Grant from the United States Department of Justice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Taylorsville City Council that the Grant is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the same.

This Resolution, assigned No. 16-24, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
