RE: Request to open the Garfield County one-year prioritized Capital Improvements List

Dear Mr. Zabriskie,

The following is forwarded in confirmation of recent discussion between you and our Engineer, BOSS Engineering, regarding the subject list and our need to have our renewable energy project placed upon the subject list.

Ticaboo Electric Improvement District (TEID) is requesting that the Utah Permanent Community Impact Board Garfield County One-Year Prioritized List re-opened for the inclusion of an additional project for our electrical district. The project is to design and construct a renewable energy source as the primary power supply for our area. Currently we are using powered generators which create a very high cost burden on the area residents and commercial facilities. The proposed renewable energy project would be consistent with the Charter whereby our District was created in November 2009 and would permit affordable electrical service in the area. The overall cost of this project is estimated to be \$1,668,250. TEID is prepared to request funding for this project in 2011. TEID anticipates submitting this project to the PCIB before June 1, 2011, so it can be included in the next trimester funding cycle.
