



NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

Utah Transit Authority (UTA) hereby gives notice that they have coordinated with the Mountainland Association of Governments (MAG) to assure that the procedures established in the MAG's public involvement policy, including public notice and time established for public review and comment on the transportation improvement program (TIP), satisfy the Requirement of public participation in the development of the program of projects and grant application requirements of the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Urbanized Area Formula Program, Section 5307; and other FTA formula funds. The public participation requirements of 49 U.S.C. Section 5307 (b) (1) through (b) (7) (as amended by Map-21) are integrated into MAG's adopted "Public Involvement Policy".
