

would be not to exceed \$1.8 million and a fifteen year participation period. Each taxing entity has the right to determine whether they want to participate or don't. Of the \$1.8 million, \$355,000 would come from South Salt Lake. The rest would come from the other taxing districts. There is a very good possibility that one or more of the entities may not agree to participate at that amount or may agree to participate less.

Director Rapp asked if staff knew what the developer would do if they don't move forward with this.

Mr. Sant said the developer was asked that and they said they still like moving forward with the project but they do need the increment and they would have to go through the process and see what it is, then make some determination to what they would do. They would certainly not be able to build the project at the scale that they have proposed without the increment.

Mr. Sant emphasized that all the Board is doing tonight is to just moving this forward. They are not approving, as a Board, any participation. They are just authorizing the staff to take the project forward, go through the budget process, talk to the taxing entities, see what they will do and then they have to bring all of the local entities back to the Board and then the Agency takes action. The action tonight is to only allow staff to go through the process of requesting tax increment participation from all of the taxing entities to the \$1.8 million. If they don't get the full amount the developer still has to take a look at the project and come back and make some decisions as to what he would be willing to do.

Mr. Sant suggested they could ask for a letter from the developer regarding what changes he would make if he didn't get any tax increment. He knows they believe in the location, they think the housing is significantly important to the community, they believe it will clean up the area, help reduce crime, and it's a marketable rental product. If they down scale it might affect the rents and turn it into more of an affordable product. They don't know that yet because they don't know what the impact will be. Mr. Sant said they want a first class product to come out on the streetcar line so it sets the tone for other development. He thinks the first guy out deserves some assistance. It is an important project. It is significant to the streetcar line and that is why he is recommending participation.

Director Snow said she has heard conflicting information on what the developer might do and would like to get a letter from them to get a clear response.

Mr. Sant said he will get the letter from the developer.

Director Siwik ask that the developer state in the letter what they will do if they get increment as well as what they won't do if they don't get the increment.

Mr. Sant agreed to do that.

Director Beverly suggested the Board could get the letter and move forward with this because it doesn't bind them into anything at this point so why not get started in the process.

Mr. Sant agreed saying they are not binding anybody. They are only authorizing staff to go through the process.

Director Beverly moved to approve proceeding on the Zellerbach project tax increment with the taxing entities.

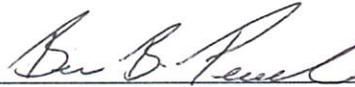

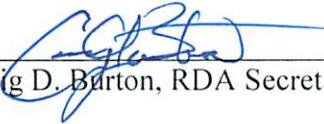
