2009-2010 Trustlands Budget was reviewed. Principal Robinson addressed the original budget and the actual expenditures. The State will pay for the Common Core Academy. Ashman will pay for the Summer Core Academy with some of the balance of \$16,792.00 in the trustland fund. The science lab is on hold because the state is increasing requirements. The beginning balance of trustland money is \$22,679. \$3500 was spent in tech support, \$500 for community council chair stipend, \$3500 for Ticket to Read program, \$650 for Education City Math was not renewed, \$1688 for Imagine It was not renewed, \$2100 For classroom libraries is on hold as Ashman will be losing staff, \$477 for wireless airports for I Observation is up and working. The budget worksheet details money spent from 9/14/10-2/8/11.

Principal Robinson gave a report on Liberty Kids & iObservation. Yearly Progress Pro will help classes work toward "green dot" parties for 175 math dots classwide. New Common Core standards in language arts and math will aim to teach thinking strategy not just information. 1 teacher and 5 aides will be lost in 2011-2012 due to budget cuts.
