Food Service Regulation

- Originally passed in September 1980
- Proposed changes include:
 - Adopt State Rule and 2013 FDA Food Code
 - Mobile and Temporary flexibility
 - Update fees
 - Standardize Department formatting



Food Service Regulation Public Hearing

- June 28, 2016
- Received 3 public comments
 1. General questions with new application (support)
 1. Clarity on 5.5.1
 2. Food limitations—“are limited to ice, flavored syrups, and the following ingredients”
 2. Pets on “premises”
 3. Education request
- Proposed changes are not in conflict with other rules and continue to protect public health



Waste Tire Regulation

- Specific state program and rules
- Current issues
- Proposed Changes include:
 - Addressing nuisance and fire hazard issues
 - Adopting State Rule R315-314 and R315-320
 - Updating fees for waste tire transporters
 - Standardizing Department formatting



Open Burning Regulation

- Originally adopted in 1971
- Proposed changes include:
 - Adopting R307-202
 - New requirement that burning permit or approval be issued by municipal fire authority
 - Changing maximum recreational fire size
 - Standardizing Department formatting
- Public Hearing Request
