- The meeting is called to order by Chief Hansen.
- Next meeting: November 2, 2016 at 8:30 am at BCI
- The board moves to approve the minutes from the April meeting. Weldon Andersen motions to approve, Joshua Massey seconds and all are in favor.
- The board moves to suspensions so that Agent Barrett can leave the meeting early to attend another meeting he has.

Dale Robbins: Agent Barrett tells the board of Mr Robbins arrest. Steve Ketter lets the board know that he knows the licensee and that the licensee is getting everything taken care of. Marcus Yockey of the State swears in Agent Barrett and Mr Robbins so that they may address the board and testify.

The board has Agent Barrett recount what he found in his investigation. Afterwards, the board has Mr Robbins give his account of his arrest. Mr Robbins gives an update on where his case is at and what is in the process of happening for it. Chief Hansen expresses his concerns with what happened in the incident and asks more questions of Mr Robbins. The board looks over the file Agent Barrett brought with him as they ask questions and let Mr Robbins continue to testify. Joshua Massey asks if the board can close the meeting to discuss this or if they need to continue on record and openly discuss this case. The board needs to keep it an open meeting, as this doesn't fit under the circumstances to which a meeting would be closed. The board asks more questions and refers back to Marcus Yockey as to what action they can take. Weldon Andersen and Joshua Massey give their thoughts on what they would like to see the board do with Mr Robbins license. Chief Hansen talks about how Law enforcement officers as well as bail licensees are here to be safe and change bad behavior. He expresses his concerns with this incident. Mr Robbins addresses the board again with the changes his company has been through to be safer. The board discusses what they would like to see happen with Mr Robbins license. They discuss actions that will allow Mr Robbins to later get his license back but would like to see some time for learning to take place. Weldon Andersen motions to put Mr Robbins license into a probation status for 12 months. If during those 12 months there are no new violations and Mr Robbins promises to notify Law Enforcement of entering homes 24 hours before he does his license may be reinstated. Joshua Massey seconds and all are in favor.
