

**ORDINANCE 3-2016  
HUNTINGTON CITY**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HUNTINGTON PARKING REGULATIONS 6-2-3 AND  
TRUCK REGULATIONS. 6-3-1 B.**

**WHEREAS, the Huntington City Council desires to make technical changes to the parking ordinance and truck regulations by having a clear and concise policy regarding these limitations, and**

**WHEREAS, the Huntington City Council finds that it is desirable to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Huntington City and to promote and maintain property values in the city.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Huntington Parking Regulations and Truck Regulations; the City Council of Huntington, Utah, hereby adopts and passes the following;**

**6-2-3: CAMPERS, TRAILERS, BOATS RESTRICTED: It shall be a violation of City Codes for any person to park or leave standing on any public road or street, any camper, trailer, boat, motor home or other recreational vehicle for more than seven (7) days and any vehicle so parked and left standing may be subject to impoundment.**

**6-3-1:**

**B. Residential Area: No truck or truck trailer with a rated capacity of one and one-half (1 ½) tons or more, licensed for more than eighteen thousand (18,000) pounds' gross shall be allowed to be parked on the public streets in a residential area for a period of time in excess of two (2) hours.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Huntington City Council.**

**PASSED and posted by unanimous vote of the Huntington City Council at the regularly scheduled meeting of the Council on the 20th day of July, 2016.**
