BACKGROUND DISCUSSION:

In October 2015, the City Council approved the West Jordan Secondary Water Master Plan which identified \$16M in infrastructure for Option 1 (dry pipe systems only) or \$72M in infrastructure for Option 2 (full build out). To supplement the fiscal study that is done as part of the Master Plan, staff recommended consulting with a financial firm to evaluate the entire financial implications of a secondary water project, to identify total cost, potential funding options associated with determining the financial feasibility and potential user rate associated with the secondary water system.

On 27 April 2016, the City Council approved the contract with Zions Public Finance for the study. Zions has completed their study and will present their findings to Council.
