Project Description

The project will:

- Resurface the roadway to improve ride quality and preserve the roadway to avoid major rehabilitation
- Add bicycle lanes to provide active transportation options
- Add raised medians to improve safety and operational efficiency

Project features will address concerns on 700 East including traffic flow, crashes, pedestrian safety, while improving active transportation. UDOT has coordinated with Sandy City throughout the design process to improve safety while minimizing impact to residential and business access.




Safety Facts

- From 2010-2016, there have been 598 accidents on this section of 700 East which is a higher volume of accidents than other corridors of this size and type. The heat map on the left reflects the number of mid-block crashes within the project limits.
- Project features will increase safety for motorists, bicyclists and pedestrians by designating specific turn locations and thereby decreasing the number and severity of crashes mid-block.
- In order to improve safety and maintain access, left-turn pockets will be placed at median breaks to allow access to businesses and residential areas.
- Pedestrian ramps will be brought up to the latest federal ADA standards for safety.
- U-turns will be allowed at designated areas.
