

Dan Blanchard (AP&P) suggestions:

Section VI.B.

For **certain** offenders identified as low risk (**remove "on the LSI-SV"**) whom the sentencing authority would have previously received a full pre-sentence report, a 'Sentencing Memorandum' should still be provided by AP&P to the Court. The JRI Implementation Task Force of CCJJ agreement regarding the process for low risk offenders became effective January 28, 2016 and is included in the **2016** guidelines as **Addendum G** for specific reference.

Tool 5.

Under P.O. with Supervisor Approval row add: **Any Lower Level Response**

Will the Incarceration Caps with Hearing sections still include up arrow and hearing reference # next to the row? I think these are good visuals, and we have a clarifying statement in the top paragraph stating the cap is intended as a maximum regardless of the hearing number. If we include hearing #, I'd suggest we use "**3 +subsequent**" rather than 3 +.

Tool 6.

Combine the public safety description for both probation and parole under one merged box at the top of the list as #1, Jurisdiction remains as #2 for both and execution of previous sentence for probation moves to #3.

Tool 2A.

Wherever we use "Plate" replace with "**(Risk Reduction)**" or just remove it and not replace since the nature already indicates reduction of risk...
