**To Consider:**

Fee and fee schedule for Recycling Zone designations

In 1996, the Utah Legislature created the Utah Recycling Market Development Zone Program which focuses on recycling as an economic development tool. . . . The zone legislation was established to incent businesses to use recycled materials in their manufacturing processes and create new products for sale. It also benefits business or individuals that collect, process, distribute recycled materials. Composting is considered to be eligible recycling operation.

It is proposed that the Governor’s Office of Economic Development require an application fee for Counties and Municipalities filing formal application for the Utah Recycling Market Development Zone Program.
