

## **Ivins Fire Report – September 2016**

Trainings this month consisted of water apparatus connects and hydrants sources. This included a mutual training where we joined with the Santa Clara Fire department to have them become familiar with our connects and process and we were able to learn their connects and process.

The Fire Recruit Academy is in full swing and they are doing exceptional and we have received great feedback from State Instructors.

Ivins Fire took part in the Heritage Days festival. We received a citation for having no food handlers permit. We have been cautioned that we should not put on any further breakfasts either without having the food permit. This will require us doing some leg work and seeing if anyone from the fire department is interested in obtaining this permit, if not we may have come to an end with the tradition of the breakfasts and food serving booths.

Ivins Fire and EMS participated in the Heritage Days Parade and the Santa Clara Swiss Days Parade as well.

### **Significant calls for service:**

Ivins Fire & Rescue responded to three structure fire calls this month. One was found to be more of an electrical issue with no fire. A second was found to be a burning ceiling fan and was controlled without any damage to the home. The third was an oven that had been installed incorrectly and caught the stove on fire.

Ivins Fire assisted with two search and rescue calls in this month, both minor calls for service with more of a medical response needed with fire providing the man power required for removing the patients.
