

Minutes of the South Summit School District Board of Education Work Session Meeting held on **September 8, 2016**, beginning at 5:30 p.m. in the District Office Board Room at 285 East 400 South, Kamas, UT.

1. President Hicken called the Work Session to order at 5:30 p.m.
2. President Hicken welcomed everyone to the Work Session.

 - b. Information regarding the Prepare Access Complete Economic Success (PACE) accountability report.
 - c. Information regarding the School Federal Accountability Report (SFAR).
 - d. Student Assessment of Growth and Excellence (SAGE).
 - SAGE test will be administered to all Freshmen and Sophomores. Schools can opt out Juniors from the SAGE test if they are taking the ACT text.
6. Superintendent Sorenson wanted the Board to have this information in case stakeholders, etc. have any questions for them. The school grades will be published soon.
