MINUTES OF THE WORK MEETING OF THE GRANTSVILLE CITY COUNCIL, HELD ON OCTOBER 5, 2016 AT THE GRANTSVILLE CITY HALL, 429 EAST MAIN STREET, GRANTSVILLE, UTAH. THE MEETING BEGAN AT 6:00 P.M.

AGENDA:

1. Discussion of Ordinance 2016-13 requiring fire suppression.

Mayor Marshall turned the time over to the Deputy State Fire Marshal, Ted Black. Deputy Fire Marshal Black provided two drafted ordinances he felt would work for Grantsville City. He reviewed them. The Council discussed their concerns and thoughts. They asked Deputy Fire Marshal Black questions.

Robbie Critchlow addressed the Council. He said as the next Fire Chief, he would like to see a standard set. He stated the code requires 1,000 gallons per minute. He checked 200 fire hydrants in this town. He found one with that. Mr. Critchlow explained it is supposed to be up on Sevier Street, but there is no water pressure so he does not know if that is legitimate or not. He said he will have to go test it again. He reported the average flow is about 500 – 600 gallons per minute. He added there was a home that was passed off using five (5) gallon buckets.

The Council continued their discussion to determine what would be best for Grantsville.
