Pledge of Allegiance

The bouldering Festival is scheduled for Oct 6-8th. There will be Cowboy Games and a Rodeo on Friday, October 7th at the indoor arena. An opening party will follow.

On Saturday, October 8th there will be several clinics in Straight and Cottonwood Canyons. We have three or four professional rock climbing athletes coming to conduct the clinics. At 2:00 pm Saturday will be a trade fair at the Rec Center.

The athletes I have talked to are excited that Castle Dale and Orangeville are welcoming the climbers.

Jared Lofthouse: Ordinance Enforcement

Everything is going smoothly except for the horse problem. I have one property that continues to violate on secondary water, but I got a new lead on that today. There have been several travel trailers parked on streets, but they comply when notified.

Ignacio Arrien:Fire Report

The Burn Window in Sept 15 to Nov 15 this year.
On Oct 12 we are going to Castle Dale Elementary for Fire Week.

City Report

The Welcome Center is cleaned except for the floor. The Building Inspector is coming Thursday for the final inspection. The restrooms will be closed on Sept 26 except for the concession stand which will be open for the Bouldering Festival.

Brad Giles noted that there is Little League Football in Cheddar Park. Nosh will call the Rec Dept for a schedule before closing those restrooms.

Sidewalks: We are starting on main Street now. We have replaced 2023' of sidewalks and have 890' left. The total for sidewalks will be \$61,000. This is over budget as I had not calculated approaches.

J&D Auto wants a new approach, we will replace their sidewalk, but will bill them for the approach.

On October 3rd we will get asphalt to repair the roads.

On the New City Hall, the fire suppression lines have been flushed. The Fire Marshall has authorized me to do the final inspection.

Treasurer Report

Jackie asked how much to bill for the concession stand during the Lamb Fry and who to bill. It will be \$25 per day. Joel gave her a contact number for Troy Winters.

Council Reports

Joel Dorsch requested a drawing of the finished new City Hall

Brad Giles: The 2017 want list for the CVSSD for the CIB Grants is Esquire Parkway apron and asphalt, a wall on the south side of the hill on 200 North.

The Council discussed storm drains on Esquire Parkway.

Julie Johansen: I am on the committee for EMS. I need to know the Council's concerns and opinions to represent us. She noted that there will be eleven members, with one coming from the County, and one from each City and one will be a doctor.

Brad Giles doesn't like how the agreement is written.

Mayor Van Wagoner: The person who represents our City needs to know about EMS. It would be good if he or she was an EMT.

Doug Weaver: We had someone collect their dog without paying the fine. The fine is \$30 unless Seth lets the office know otherwise. I think our system is working except in this case and want to

keep the same system.

Mayor Van Wagoner: The new building is 40% finished. It is still nine days behind schedule. I have met with the Sterling Scholars and they agreed to help man the Visitor's Center. We are getting a sign for it, and should open soon.
