RESOLUTION NO. 17-

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO WORK
WITH SALT LAKE COUNTY TO PREPARE AN
APPLICATION TO OBTAIN SECTION 5310 FUNDS FOR
SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS AT QUALIFIED
LOCATIONS IN MILLCREEK**

WHEREAS, the Millcreek Council (the “*Council*”) met in regular session on February 21st, 2017, to consider, among other things, authorizing the Mayor to work with Salt Lake County to prepare an application to obtain Section 5310 funds for sidewalk improvements at qualified locations in Millcreek; and

WHEREAS, 49 USC §5310 provides formula funding to states for the purpose of assisting private nonprofit groups in meeting the transportation needs of older adults and people with disabilities when the transportation service is unavailable, insufficient, or inappropriate to meeting these needs; and

WHEREAS, the City has received notice that the Federal Transit Administration has authorized certain funding within the State of Utah pursuant to section 5310, and that the Utah Department of Transportation is accepting applications for section 5310 grants; and

WHEREAS, sidewalks needed in at least two areas located within the City meet the requirements to receive section 5310 grants; and

WHEREAS, whereas a section 5310 grant would require a 20 percent match by the City, but the 5310 funds will not be made available until 2018; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City to apply now for section 5310 grants for funding in 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council authorizes and directs the Mayor to work with Salt Lake County to prepare an application to obtain Section 5310 funds for sidewalk improvements at qualified locations in Millcreek.

This Resolution assigned No. 17-___, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
