ITEM 1* The Provo City Housing Authority, requests that the historic designation for the George Taylor Jr. home, generally located at 187 North 400 West, which is in the Downtown 1 zone, be changed from contributory to non-contributory. ***Timp Neighborhood***

Decisions on items involving either landmark designation or the refusal to issue a Certificate of Historic Appropriateness may be appealed to the Municipal Council **within thirty (30) days of the decision of the Commission** per Section 16.03 of the Provo City Code.
