

**AMENDED REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR  
PROFESSIONAL CONSULTING/ENGINEERING SERVICES  
GRANTSVILLE CITY IMPACT FEE FACILITIES PLANS  
AND IMPACT FEE STUDIES  
(Deadline Extended to October 24, 2011)**

Grantsville City Corporation is requesting proposals from qualified professional consulting/engineering firms to provide services as described herein and in a separate specification list which is available upon request. The work includes the adoption of new impact fee facilities plans and impact fee studies for water supply, treatment and distribution facilities; wastewater collection and treatment facilities; parks, recreation facilities, open space and trails; public safety facilities, storm water, drainage and flood control facilities; and roadway facilities.

Experience in this type of work is preferred. A written statement of qualifications and fees for the services will be accepted at the Grantsville City Offices, located at 429 East Main Street, Grantsville, Utah 84029 until 5:00 p.m. on Monday October 24, 2011. The previous deadline for acceptance of proposals was Wednesday, September 28, 2011. This extension is the result of the unavailability of the City's Public Works Director who was expected to be available to answer questions regarding the proposed work. Grantsville City will not accept any RFQ/RFP submittal by facsimile, electronic transmission or any method other than that stated above. Grantsville City reserves the right not to issue a contract and to cancel or modify this solicitation at any time if it deems, in its sole discretion, that such measures are in Grantsville's best interests. It is anticipated that the RFP/RFQs will be formally considered and awarded at the City Council meeting on November 2, 2011 at the 7:00 p.m. meeting.
