-Attorney, Preston Kirk - In 2008, WCSD issued approximately \$14 million in general obligation bonds to build WHS (2008- 4.2% interest rates). Board is recognizing the current low interest rate environment that will save patrons money (2017 – rates as low as 2%, Anticipate to save approx. \$93,000 per year or \$900,000 over the next ten years).

- Attorney, Randy Larsen - Bond Resolution presented to board to refund bonds. Parameters include length of maturity, term certificates and interest rate. Also note the Bond purchase agreement and escrow agreement. I would recommend approval for this bond resolution.
