

PROPOSITION #1

Shall the Board of Education of Alpine School District, Utah County, Utah, be authorized to issue general obligation bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$210,000,000 and to mature in no more than 20 years from the date or dates of issuance of such bonds for the purpose of raising money for purchasing one or more school sites, buildings and furnishings and improving existing school property under the charge of the Board of Education, and, to the extent necessary, for providing moneys for the refunding, at or prior to the maturity thereof, of general obligation bonds of the Board authorized hereunder or heretofore issued and now outstanding?

PROPERTY TAX COST OF BONDS

If the bonds are issued as planned, an annual property tax to pay debt service on the bonds will be required over a period of 20 years in the estimated amount of \$38 on a \$224,500 residence, and in the estimated amount of \$69 on a business property having the same value.

The Board has other outstanding general obligation bonds; an otherwise scheduled tax decrease may not occur if these bonds are issued.

The foregoing information is only an estimate and is not a limit on the amount of taxes that the governing body may be required to levy in order to pay debt service on the bonds. The governing body is obligated to levy taxes to the extent provided by law in order to pay the bonds.
