SOUTH JORDAN ANNOUNCES PROCESS TO FILL VACANCY IN MAYOR'S SEAT

SOUTH JORDAN, Utah – At the regularly scheduled City Council Meeting on December 6, 2011, South Jordan City elected officials determined the process to be followed in filling the upcoming vacancy in the Mayor's seat. The vacancy will be created when Mayor W. Kent Money steps down on February 1, 2012. Mayor Money has taken a new work assignment with his full time employer, The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, which will require him to relocate to New Zealand. Money has two years remaining in this term of office. The remaining time will be filled by an individual appointed by the City Council.

Individuals interested in being considered for the mayoral position must appear in person at the office of the City Recorder of South Jordan, located at 1600 West Towne Center Drive, South Jordan, UT 84095. The individual will be given a "Declaration of Candidacy" form to fill out and sign in the presence of the City Recorder or authorized deputy. Interested persons are also requested to submit a brief resume at that time.

Submissions will be received by the office of the City Recorder of South Jordan City beginning at 8:00 am on Wednesday, December 7, 2011, and will not be accepted after 12:00 p.m. (Noon) on Thursday, December 22, 2011. Interested persons must be a registered voter in South Jordan City and have been a resident of South Jordan for the consecutive 12 month period immediately prior to the appointment to fill the vacancy.

It is the intent of the City Council to deliberate and vote to fill the vacancy at the regularly scheduled Council meeting to be held at 6:00 pm, Tuesday, January 3, 2012, in the Council Chambers at South Jordan City Hall. City Hall is located at 1600 West Towne Center Drive, South Jordan, Utah 84095. Interested persons may be asked to address the City Council during the January 3 meeting. The City Council may choose to go into a closed session (not open to the public) to discuss the character and competency of interested person(s). The selection vote will be held during the open public meeting.
