Myron,

Hurricane City would like to request \$30,000 of DMPO Planning Funds to perform a planning study that would help the City develop, analyze and compare several alignment alternatives for the proposed connection from Hurricane across the Virgin River to Babylon Road. This is one of the corridors that Mayor Bramall has mentioned on multiple occasions in DTEC. The City's master plan shows the connection being an extension of 2800 West, which extends north from the proposed intersection of the Southern Parkway and SR-9. However, there has not been any conceptual design work completed to analyze the details of such an effort.

The City is in the midst of updating the Transportation Master Plan. This project, along with development pressure in the area is spurring the City to identify a defensible corridor on the masterplan. I anticipate that the results of this study would be very helpful in a future NEPA effort for a future river crossing.
