Concealed Weapons Class

8 Participants

Every couple months we offer a Concealed Weapons Class for people to get their Concealed Carry Permit. This class is taught by Patrick Burden who has been teaching people about concealed weapons for years. He is very passionate about this subject and is a great instructor of the class. He loves the people up here and enjoys coming from Salt Lake to teach this class.

I make sure he has a classroom reserved and anything else he needs to put on this class. This program is great and people seem to really enjoy the way he teaches the class.

Boys Baseball

169 Participants

We have 3 age divisions for the older kids AA, AAA and Major league Teams. We will have 5 teams in AA which will play on Gutierrez field that play on Monday nights at 5:00 & 6:45, 5 Teams in AAA which play on Gutierrez field on Tuesday nights at 5:00 & 6:45 and 3 in the majors division which play on Tuesday nights on Public Works field at 5:00 & 6:45. Cost for this program is \$60. We use high school kids/players and other people from the community to help us out umping.

The younger kids will start T-Ball and Coach Pitch in the month of June.

Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu

30 kids/ 4 adults

This is a 6 week session that is held on Tuesdays and Thursdays at the Rec Center April 10th-May 17th in the East classroom.

Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu is the art of using grappling skills, positions, and submissions to subdue a larger and stronger opponent. BJJ is also an exciting and fun sport that involves throws, takedowns, chokes and joint locks. Kids enrolled in the program will learn self-defense, increase core strength, improve flexibility, and gain confidence. Instructors are Flavio Behring Jiu-Jitsu USA purple belts. Wear your shorts and a t-shirt and come join the fun!

We ended this program this month with another great turn out and a lot of positive feedback. The instructors will be offering another session shortly and hopefully the program continues to grow.

Spring Soccer

693 Participants

Spring Soccer is one of our biggest programs of the year. The Season began April 14th and will go through May 8th on Tuesdays and Saturdays. Games will be held at South Field Park. Along with the season the Girls High School Coach also offers two players clinics that the kids can go work on some drills and learn from the Girls High School soccer team.

With this being one of our biggest programs, we help Kylee with finding coaches and getting ready for the season to begin. We also help her set up/take down all the fields on Tuesdays and Saturdays. With this many kids in the program we also help with the many questions that are asked on any given game day.

We have created a new league, Tiny Tots, for kids ages 3 and 4 yrs. Old. We introduced Tiny Tots for the Fall 2017 season and saw that we had great participation and it was successful. We have about 100 total teams playing.

Girls Beginning Fast Pitch:

Girl's softball, beginning fast pitch and fast pitch, has been struggling to get participation for a few years now. We have not been able to have a 6th- 9th grade fast pitch league for a few years now due to low participation numbers. Beginning fast pitch has typically been able to have 3-4 teams each year.

Track Club

128 Participats

Track Club will be April 24- June 5th on Tuesdays and Thursdays at the High School Track.

The object of Track Club is to expose as many kids as possible to the sport. Track is a great sport and it also teaches the basic movements and coordination for many other sports, as well as great fitness. Coach Amylee Nicoll and her other coaches help the kids at practices with all aspects of Track. Teaching them form and stretches to help them better themselves in each event. We will attend 3 Track Meets this year, where the kids compete against other programs in our state. At the end of the season we attend a final meet where kids will compete to earn a medal in different events.

This program keeps on growing every year and the kids have a lot of fun! I will help Amy with any equipment she needs or finding some coaches to help her out. I also coordinate with the High School so we can use their track. We are very thankful for them and the support they give this program! Coach Foster the High School Track Coach also helps us with volunteer coaches and he also assists in whatever way he can. This program is very successful because of everyone involved. Coach Amy is great and I hope to have her around for many years to come!

Men's Softball

17 Teams 221 Participants

Men's Softball has had another great turn out this year! The season begins April 30th and will finish with a tournament in July. We will be playing at Vets Park and be using 3 fields on Monday Nights. There is an A League and a B League and teams are able to choose which one they want to play in.

I make sure our grounds crew has all the information to prep the fields and that the fields are prepped. As well as coordinating with Umpires and having game balls for them. I will turn on the lights as the night goes on and off when we are finished. I stay at the park all night until games are over. Answering any questions and taking care of any issues that come up.

Hunter Safety -

23 Participants

New class just started this month.

This class is required by the state of Utah and the DNR for kids or adults that would like to get a hunting license. After completing this class they will receive their “blue card” that will allow them to apply for hunting tag with the state. They attend class for 7 weeks and finish up with a written and shooting test at the end. The shooting test is held at the Gun Club in Daniel. This class is taught by Ed Mason at the Rec. center classroom, cost is \$25. Next class will be held starting August 6th.

Tennis-

Spring Session 2 session was April 23rd - May 30th. Tennis is taught by Bill Damron of Timp Valley Tennis. Bill teaches classes Monday through Friday from 2:30-5:30pm. Tennis is offered to kids 1st grade through high school. Kids are checked in everyday to make sure everyone who is attending class has registered and signed our liability waiver.

Timp Valley Tennis is now offering Women’s Tennis classes for beginners as well as intermediate players. Classes are taught from 9:00am to 12:00pm Monday through Thursday.

Gymnastics -

114 Participants

Classes - there are fewer students in the classes this time due to end of school activities. Classes are taught By Steve Lake (Head), Natalie Mickelson, Julene Rayner, Elizabeth Taylor. We have 14 different class being taught here at the Rec Center, classes are on Wednesday 4:30 - 8:00 and Thursdays 5-8 we have added a Monday night class that started in May. Cost for class ranges from \$56 to \$200 depending on the class for the 4 week session. Classes are taught on Court 6.
