### **UHSRA Queen Contest**

Battling the same problem we have at the Mountain Valley Stampede, numbers at this event are dramatically down from past years. This year's contest was attend by only six contestants. Although the competition is very good the numbers don't seem to be going up.

### **UHSRF (Utah High School Rodeo Finals)**

Contrary to the Queen Contest numbers, the UHSRA is stronger and bigger than ever. The finals this year was as big as we have had in the 43 years of hosting this event. Due to the Junior Associations creating interest in the sport of Rodeo we have had great growth with our contestant numbers. The numbers for this year's stall rental is 480 Stalls for the total of \$ 41,059.59 Total Camping 288 Spots total of \$ 11,412.52

### **4 H Practice**

4 H practice nights have been a part of our summer activities for many years. Most every Tuesday night our arena is filed with youth from around our valley receiving instruction on how to be a better Horseman. We appreciate the many great instructors that spend time with the youth that desire to learn more about this great program. It is a pleaser to be a part of this event.

### **4H Horse Show**

This is an all Equestrian event, challenging the contestants with events that consist of speed and showmanship. The numbers have declined through the years due to other associations cropping up in the equestrian world, such as the Utah Junior Rodeo and Jr High Rodeo associations. This has constantly been pulling from the pool of younger Horse enthusiasts. Mr. Sulser from the Utah State Extension office stated that he is working to increase participation in this program by working with the younger Children from our County.

### **Caps Horse Health Symposium**

This is an educational event provided by the CAPS program from the Wasatch High School allowing students to grow in lives experiences dealing with educating the public on Horses health.

### **Mountain Valley Stampede Jr Division Queen contest**

Under the direction of Chris Price the Mountain Valley Stampede Queen Director the contest went very well for the first year. We had 7 contestants and a lot of smiles. This has been a great move to grow our contestant base.

### **Double Down Lamb Show**

This event is produced by Lance Jepperson a local Sheep enthusiast. Showcasing lambs and Goats this event has grown in size through the last three years. This year we pulled people from ten states and gave out over \$20,000.00 in cash and prizes. We rented 48 stalls and had a rental income of \$1,500.00
