Matters for Discussion

- 1. Equal Pay HR Policy. Mayor Wood said that staff is working on this. There are other HR policy changes that need to be made as well so that is all being done at the same time.
- 2. Parental Leave Pay HR Policy. Mayor Wood said the City reached out to Midvale to see what their policy entailed. Midvale is still working on their policy and South Salt Lake is currently working on a policy as well.
- 3. Elected Officials Salary Compensation. Council Member Kindred reached out to Provo and they said members of the community that are known by the Mayor or Council are selected for the elected official's salary committee, there is no application process. The salary study is collected by Provo City HR.

The Council had a lengthy discussion on how best to select a committee and when to have the committee meet.

Council Attorney, Doug Ahlstrom, will work on a draft ordinance and the Council will bring this item back at a future meeting date.

4. Discussion of Open to All. Council Member deWolfe said Open to All is a nationwide engagement campaign to build understanding and discussion about the importance of our nation's non-discrimination laws and the bedrock principal that when businesses open their doors to the public that they should be open to all. There is a decal available that businesses can display on their door to announce that anyone is welcome.

Mayor Wood has said this group would like a donation for the decals and she has concerns about asking businesses for money in addition to the fees they already pay for their business licenses. The City could look into whether it would be appropriate add it to the business license application as an optional fee and make it clear the fee goes towards the Open to All campaign.
