The purpose of the public hearing is to review and receive comments on projects in federal grant applications that are to be submitted to the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) in Federal Fiscal Year 2012. The applications will be explained, questions answered and comments recorded for the public record.

Federal Funding: Federal Transit Administration  
Utah Transit Authority is the designated recipient of Section 5307 Formula apportioned transit funds based on population, miles of revenue service, and passengers. The Section 5307 program is funded by the Federal Transit Administration at 80 percent federal and 20 percent local match. The federal amount available in the Section 5307 program for fiscal year 2012 will be approximately \$41 million. The local match of approximately \$10.3 million is paid by UTA from local option sales tax/local revenues.

VI.
