

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given by Millard County that there shall be a 45 day public comment period from August 1, 2012 through September 18, 2012 for the purpose of providing comments regarding Millard County's intended use of part or all of the funds received from "The Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000, Title III" (Act) for the following purposes: reimbursement for expenditures incurred as a result of the wildland fire that included United States Forest Service property, known as the Clay Springs Fire; any additional expenditures that may be incurred on United States Forest Service property through September 30, 2013; and the establishment and activity related to the community wild fire protection plan known as: "Community Fire Plan for the Wildland – Urban Interface" for the areas of Kanosh Town, Kanosh Paiute Reservation, Historic Cove Fort and Frampton Heights Subdivision in Millard County, Utah.

It is further noted that Millard County inadvertently did not advertise some of these projects in advance of them actually happening. However, no funds from the Act have actually been expended at this time and will not be spent until after the expiration of the 45-day public comment period.
