The applications are then sent to the Governor's Office of Economic Development (GOED) Board for final approval.

  - a. Everwood, Inc., Honeyville, Box Elder County
    - i. Rural Fast Track Grant for Everwood, Inc., located in Honeyville, Box Elder County, for the purpose of purchasing a wide belt sander. The company expects to create one (1) new full-time position paying at least 110% of the county average wage. The total project cost is valued at One hundred fifteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$115,500).
    - ii. **MOTION: Endorse a Rural Fast Track Grant for the company in the amount of \$50,000.**

  - b. Andy Cox Electrical, Manti, Sanpete County
    - i. Rural Fast Track Grant for Andy Cox Electrical, located in Manti, Sanpete County, for the purpose of purchasing an HMI polyurethane trailer system and pickup truck. The company expects to create one (1) new full-time position

paying at least 110% of the county average wage. The total project cost is valued at Fifty five thousand dollars (\$55,000).

ii. **MOTION: Endorse a Rural Fast Track Grant for the company in the amount of \$27,500.**
