

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AN IMPACT FEE ANALYSIS FOR CULINARY WATER, SECONDARY WATER, SEWER, TRANSPORTATION, STORM DRAIN, PUBLIC SAFETY, PARKS AND RECREATION, AND ELECTRICAL IMPACT FEES AND OF THE INTENT TO ADOPT REVISED IMPACT FEES FOR CULINARY WATER, SECONDARY WATER, SEWER, TRANSPORTATION, STORM DRAIN, PUBLIC SAFETY, PARKS AND RECREATION, AND ELECTRICAL**

Notice is hereby given that Eagle Mountain City, Utah, intends to adopt an Impact Fee Analysis for the provision of culinary water, secondary water, sewer, transportation, storm drain, public safety, parks and recreation, and electrical facilities operated by the City. Eagle Mountain City Council will hold a Public Hearing at 1650 East Stagecoach Run, Eagle Mountain, Utah, at 7 p.m. (or as soon thereafter as possible) on October 16, 2012. The purpose of the Public Hearings is to receive input and consider approval and adoption of the Impact Fee Analysis. All interested persons shall be given the opportunity to be heard. Written concerns are welcome.

A copy of the Impact Fee Analysis is available for public review on the City website and public library. Documents are also available at the City Recorder's Office. In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, the City will make reasonable accommodations to participants in the hearing.
