## March 2019 Event Assessment

### **Timpanogos Archers**

This is our 7<sup>th</sup> Year hosting this event. We have seen a significant increase of participants through the years that we have been hosting this event. However our numbers were down slightly this year. There was a slide in the Canyon. We think this discouraged people driving to the event from Utah County. The number of participants were around 650. This is the largest indoor shoot with a 90 yard shot.

### **South Summit Jr High Rodeo**

We have hosted this event for the past 3 years. We sold 241 stalls for a total of \$11,422.81 The UHJRA has increased its membership every year, as a result it has increased the participation growing this event. We are very happy to be a part of this youth driven event, which utilizes our facility and brings hundreds of thousands of indirect dollars to our community.

### **Heber Buckle Blowout (Zane Danzy) Utah 5<sup>th</sup> and Under**

This event was a trade for the cattle that we lease for the winter. There was a total of 400 teams at this roping, creating a great impact on our uptown business. Zane allowed the Utah 5<sup>th</sup> and under State finals to share his arena time. We sold 51 stalls a total of \$2,416.38 we also charged the Utah 5<sup>th</sup> and under \$1,200.00 for the use of the arena.

### **Kessler Roping (Heber City Qualifier)**

The event is part of the World Series Roping Championship, A multimillion dollar roping held in Las Vegas Nevada. Because of this prestigious event there are many Ropers trying to Qualify, bringing them to our community to participate. We had over 800 teams to compete for the two days. Most of these ropers live close so we didn't have many that stalled there horses. We sold 15 stalls and brought in \$1,475.00 for building rental.
