

**SANPETE COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING**

**August 21, 2012, 2:00 P.M.**

Sanpete County Courthouse, 160 North Main, Room 101, Manti, Utah

Present are: Commission Chair Claudia Jarrett, Commissioners Spencer Cox and Steve Frischknecht, County Attorney Brody Keisel, and County Clerk Sandy Neill.

Meeting is called to order by Commission Chair Claudia Jarrett.

**KIMBALL AND ROBERTS: PRESENTATION OF AUDIT**

Kay Kimball, Rick Roberts, Ilene Roth, and Sheriff Brian Nielson are present. The audit for the year ending December 31, 2011 is reviewed. The audit was conducted in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America, and the State of Utah Legal Compliance Audit Guide. Sanpete County complied in all material respects with the general compliance requirements. There were no findings to report.

**CHAD BOOTH: DISCUSSION OF THE COUNTY SEAT PROGRAM**

No one appeared for this matter.

**CLAIMS**

Auditor Ilene Roth is present. Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to approve payment of claims #329087 through #329208. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox, and the motion passes.

**APPROVAL TO PAY CRAIG RASMUSSEN AND BARB GARDNER FOR CWPP WORK**

Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to approve the payment of \$15,500.00 to Craig Rasmussen for the Fairview/Milburn, Gooseberry/Tucker, Twin Creek/Spring City and Manti CWPPs, and \$3,995.00 to Barb Gardner for the Panorama Woods CWPP. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox and the motion passes.

**APPROVAL TO PAY UTAH ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES (UAC) FOR A COST BENEFIT ASSESSMENT OF COUNTY CONTRACTS WITH THE STATE OF UTAH REGARDING HOUSING PRISONERS IN COUNTY JAILS**

UAC is proposing to arrange to have a cost benefit assessment of the jail contracts done. They are asking the counties who contract for inmates to divide the cost of assessment. The Commissioners are concerned that the cost is evenly divided, but some counties house more state inmates, and will benefit more from this study. Sheriff Nielson offers to use funds from his office supplies budget for our portion of the assessment. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve the payment of \$1,100.00 to UAC for the cost benefit assessment of county contracts with the State of Utah regarding housing state prisoners in county jails. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Frischknecht, and the motion passes.

**APPROVAL OF A RESCIND LETTER TO UTAH LOCAL GOVERNMENT'S TRUST (ULGT) REGARDING DECISION NOT TO CHANGE INSURANCE PROVIDER**

Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve sending a rescind letter to ULGT regarding the County's decision not to change insurance providers. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Frischknecht, and the motion passes.

**ASSESSOR KEN BENCH: APPROVAL OF COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE TAX DOLLAR ADJUSTMENTS**

Ken Bench is present. Mr. Bench prepared a spreadsheet for improvements that were destroyed in the Wood Hollow fire. Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to remove the current tax dollars owed the destroyed improvements on these parcels. (See attached list.) The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox, and the motion passes. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve tax corrections to the following parcels: 41191-c, 10499, 21x, OSA 9801796, 764x7, 34117, OSA 9809277, OSA 9801083, 7271x6, 61493, 11077, 15951, 18313, 18313x1, 20449, 20419, and 20468. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Frischknecht and the motion passes.

**SHERIFF BRIAN NIELSON: APPROVAL TO HIRE DEREK WALK AS A FULL TIME PATROL DEPUTY; APPROVAL FOR A CREDIT CARD, CELL PHONE AND CAR WASH STIPENDS FOR DEREK WALK; APPROVAL TO HIRE TERRA JO DESPAIN AS A PART TIME CONTROL ROOM OPERATOR; APPROVAL TO HIRE MICHELLE M. CHRISTENSEN AS A PART TIME CORRECTIONS DEPUTY**

Sheriff Brian Nielson is present. Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to approve hiring Derek Walk as a full time deputy at \$15.97 per hour beginning September 6, 2012. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox, and the motion passes. Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to approve issuing a credit card to Deputy Walk with a limit of \$1,000.00, a cell phone stipend of \$38.00 per month and a car wash stipend of \$10.00 per month. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox, and the motion passes. Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to approve the hiring of Terra Jo Despain as a part time control room operator at \$11.00 per hour. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox, and the motion passes. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve the hiring of Michelle M. Christensen as a part time correctional officer at \$13.00 per hour.

**ERASEMO RIVERA: APPROVAL TO ADJUST PAYMENT PLAN ON S 27040x7**

Erasemo Rivera is present. A payment plan for his property taxes was set up in March. Mr Rivera is asking to have the payments reduced. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to change the payment schedule on S 27040x7 to \$150.00 per month beginning in September 2012. The next 4 payments will go towards 2012's taxes. Penalty and interest will stop accruing from this day forward. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Frischknecht, and the motion passes.

**SANPETE WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT: APPROVAL OF MODIFICATION NO. 1 TO THE GRANT AGREEMENT FOR THE FAIRVIEW CANYON TUNNEL REHABILITATION PROJECT PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN FUNDING**

Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to approve modification number 1 (increasing the funding) to the grant agreement for the Fairview Canyon tunnel rehabilitation project. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox, and the motion passes.

**LARRY PATTERSON: DISCUSSION OF STERLING GRAVEL PIT**

No one is present for this matter.

**APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS FOR THE SANPETE COUNTY EWP FY12 WOOD HOLLOW FIRE PROJECT, INCREASING FUNDS FOR THE PROJECT**

Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to approve the amendment to the cooperative agreements for the Sanpete County EWP FY12 Wood Hollow Fire Project. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox, and the motion passes.

**APPROVAL OF HIRING DIANE KEELER AS THE NEW CHILDREN'S JUSTICE CENTER DIRECTOR**

Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to approve the hiring of Diane Keeler as the Children's Justice Center Director at the same rate that the former director received. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox, and the motion passes.

**APPROVAL OF A RESOLUTION DECLARING SANPETE COUNTY'S DECISION NOT TO IMPOSE A TAX FOR BOTANICAL, CULTURAL, RECREATIONAL, AND ZOOLOGICAL FACILITIES**

Gunnison City Council Member Jeremy Pickett is present. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve resolution #08 21 2012, declaring Sanpete County's decision not to impose a tax for botanical, cultural, recreational, and zoological facilities. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Frischknecht, and the motion passes. This resolution will allow the cities to impose a tax based on a vote of the citizens of their city, and prohibits the County from proposing a County recreational tax on the upcoming ballot.

**DECISION RELATIVE TO WHICH PLAN SANPETE COUNTY WANTS TO APPROVE FOR SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS FUNDING**

Sanpete County has a choice between taking a 7 year rolling average (which would amount to approximately \$12,000.00), and splitting it with the school district. Or take an amount from the state which is projected to be \$836,500.00. Of that, 7% will be allocated to Title 3, the RAC gets \$66,920.00, 85% for the split between the schools and the county. Our half of that must go to the roads. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to notify the state that Sanpete would like to go with the state payment. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Frischknecht, and the motion passes.

**APPROVAL OF A LETTER TO SELECTED MEMBERS OF CONGRESS TO PROTEST BLM MANUALS**

Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to approve sending a letter to Congressmen Hal Rogers and Mike Simpson with copies to Congressman Jim Matheson, Congressman Jason Chaffetz, Senator Orrin Hatch, Senator Mike Lee, Governor Gary Herbert, and the Utah Association of Counties requesting to amend the FY 2013 Interior Appropriations Bill to expressly bar implementation of and enforcement of BLM manuals 6301 and 6320. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox, and the motion passes.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to approve the minutes from July 17, 2012 with minor corrections. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox, and the motion passes.

Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to go into executive session to discuss litigation. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Frischknecht and the motion passes.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Motion is made by Commissioner Frischknecht to go out of executive session. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Cox and the motion passes. The following action is taken as a result of the executive session: Rocky Mtn Power made a request for 911 logs of the Wood Hollow Fire. That request was originally denied by the County Attorney on the basis of an ongoing investigation. Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to approve the release of the 911 calls and associated logs for the Wood Hollow fire. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Frischknecht, and the motion passes. Sheriff Nielson asks for a clarification that the release is for the 911 calls and logs of the reporting of the Wood Hollow fire. The Commissioners agree.

Motion is made by Commissioner Cox to adjourn. The motion is seconded by Commissioner Frischknecht, and the motion passes.

The meeting is adjourned at 4:13 P.M.


WHEREAS, State law provides a mechanism for counties to impose taxes for certain facilities;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SANPETE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS as follows:


Sanpete County has no intention or desire to impose taxes at this time to support facilities as set forth in Utah Code Annotated, Section 59-12-1402.





