Additional Requirements and Conditions for Approval

- The Town of Rockville strictly prohibits the use of any language or conduct that is deemed to be a danger, threat or offense to the health, safety or welfare of the public.
- The Rockville Planning Commission shall determine whether impacts to the Town from filming operations are acceptable. The Commission may impose conditions to decrease or mitigate potential undesirable impacts and to ensure the use will not create a hazard to the community. To this end, the Town may require crowd and/or traffic control measures, fire department services or emergency medical stand-by services.
- The existing rights-of-way will not be compromised at any time without Planning Commission approval.
- The applicant will be required to provide assurances that, within an agreed upon time after filming operations cease, locations used for filming shall be cleaned and returned to the same or better conditions in existence prior to the filming operations.
- Total liability for damages associated with the commercial filming use is that of the applicant.

Fees

- The application fee for a Commercial Film Production Permit shall be included with the application.
- An additional daily permit fee, based on the number of days of production, shall be assessed and be included with the application.
- Should the Rockville Planning Commission determine that extraordinary services such as crowd or traffic control, fire department services or emergency medical stand-by services are required, the applicant shall submit a copy of the written agreement(s) with the determined agency(s) prior to the commencement of filming.

Bond and Insurance Requirements


- Proof of a general public liability insurance policy with the Town of Rockville named as an additionally insured is required. The amount of this coverage shall be a minimum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000). The Planning Commission shall have authority to require adjustments (increases or decreases) to this coverage depending upon the scale of operations as described in the application.
- This section further empowers the Planning Commission to require the applicant to post bond in the minimum amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) as a guarantee against damages, need for clean-up or loss of public property. The Planning Commission may waive the bond if the applicant has demonstrated that adequate provisions to protect public property and venues are in place.

Enforcement

The Town shall have the authority to shut down any filming operations proceeding without the benefit of a filming permit or found to be in violation of the terms of this section. This article may be further enforced in accordance with Section 1.19 of the Land Use Code. The Town is also authorized to bring a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction to recover any costs that it incurs which are not otherwise reimbursed by the applicant, which costs shall include reasonable legal fees to the prevailing party.

APPLICANT CERTIFICATION

The plans for shooting 'The Town' music video aren't too extensive. We hope to be able to use the town of Grafton for 1-2 days for a music video shoot location. We will have a crew of no more than 4 people and a simple camera / audio setup. The general idea of the music video is: a man wakes up on the floor in one of the Grafton houses and slowly makes his way outside where he dances around the exterior of the towns buildings for the majority of the video. We thought use of the front porch of the main house would be ideal for a few shots. But the majority will be filmed outside on the dirt roads. That's the main idea of it. One other optional idea we had (pending your thoughts) is to use the underground room of the main house to film a man playing chess. Ideally he would set a few of the wooden chess pieces on fire using matches. I'm not sure what precautions there are for something like that so I'm open to direction on that matter.
