NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING, PLAN REVIEW PERIOD, AND PUBLIC
COMMENT PERIOD REGARDING THE 2013 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR THE
USE OF CDBG FUNDS

A public hearing will be held before the South Jordan City Council following a public review and comment period regarding the draft annual action plan for the use of Community Development Block Grant Funds (CDBG) funds by South Jordan City during the 2013-2014 program year. The draft 2013 Annual Action Plan (2013 AAP) will be available for review from February 16, 2013 through March 18, 2013. The 2013 AAP may be viewed on the City's website (www.sjc.utah.gov) and by hardcopy at City Hall, 1600 W. Towne Center Drive (10610 S.), South Jordan, and the Community Center, 10778 S. Redwood Road (1700 W.), South Jordan. Public comment may be submitted in writing or email through April 2, 2013. Public comments will also be heard during a public hearing to be held before the City Council on Tuesday, April 2, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. at the South Jordan City Hall.

The City's draft 2013 AAP outlines the proposed uses of CDBG funds during the 2013-2014 program year. Projects and activities are intended to assist in fulfilling the goals and objectives outlined in the 2012-2016 Consolidated Plan. It is expected that the City will receive a yearly allocation comparable to the 2012-2013 program year allocation (\$146,606). The City intends to utilize the maximum allowable funds (15%) to support local public service providers. It is also anticipated that the City will require the maximum allowable funds (20%) for program administration. The remainder of the funds are proposed to be used in accordance with previously prepared multi-year plans to address accessibility issues at City Hall and improvements at the Senior Center.

The City welcomes public review and input regarding the draft 2013 AAP. City Hall is wheelchair accessible and the City will provide reasonable accommodations for all timely requests for additional accessibility needs to review the draft 2013 AAP, provide comments, and attend the public hearing.
