A RESOLUTION TO CANCEL THE 2019 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

- **WHEREAS**, the Town of Cedar Highlands had the positions of two (2) Town Council seats, four-year term, up for election in a regular municipal election to be held on November 5, 2019; and
- **WHEREAS**, notice of the municipal election and the election filing period was published per requirements of Utah State law; and
- WHEREAS, two (2) persons filed to run for the two (2) elective offices and were unopposed; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Cedar Highlands Town Council has authority over the Town's elections and per Utah Code annotated 20A-1-206, are allowed to cancel an election when it is not needed;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Cedar Highlands Town Council does hereby cancel the regularly scheduled 2019 municipal election. The two (2) candidates who filed to run for the office of Town Council Members will take office in January 2020 to serve four-year (4) terms. This Resolution was made, voted upon, and passed by the Cedar Highlands Town Council at a regular Town Council meeting held on the 26th day of September 2019. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon signing by the Mayor and Town Clerk.
